# WEATHER RELIEF STAND



#### What is our Weather Relief Stand?

In recent years, we've seen how the effects of climate change have impacted our society. And to help the residents of Vancouvers Downtown Eastside combat extreme weather, we thought what better way than to open our weather relief stand in July of 2022.



In the summer months of extreme heat this stand supplies members of the downtown eastside with a cup of refreshing & hydrating lemonade. This stand operates June through August, Monday-Friday on a "Pay-What-You-Can" system.

And not only does the stand provide community members with chilled beverages in extreme heat; our Extreme Weather Relief stand offers employment to individuals with barriers to traditional employment. And to keep on par with our mission of the lemonade stand, in the winter months we hosted a Hot Chocolate stand to combat the extreme cold.

# SOCIAL IMPACT OF THE WEATHER RELIEF STAND

In the 2022-23 season we supplied the community with 3,486 cups of lemonade, and 5,228 cups of hot chocolate.



# EMPLOYMENT \ & TRAINING 7

In the Downtown Eastside, job stability is a challenge for many residents.

As well as **suppling over 79,471 beverages** at our weather relief stand, we've created meaningful employment opportunities for individuals who have barriers to traditional employment.

Since July 2022 our Weather Relief stand has generated over \$64,296 of peer employment income and 3,420 hours of employment to individuals from the Downtown Eastside.




#### **Peer Employment Program**

Potluck's Peer Employment Program involves hiring individuals that face barriers to traditional employment and reside on the downtown Eastside. Our peer staff work amongst the community by engaging in social programs; like the weather relief stand. that are developed to. empowering them to work within the community. They are essential for our social programming, including the Community Meal Program, Extreme Weather Relief Stands. and other Society Community Events.

Potluck has provided **\$4.4 million in wages**, equivalent to 350,000 hours of employment, to individuals residing in the poorest neighborhood of Canada.
